Our event is held as part of the Orange County Fair. It is a kid friendly, family oriented atmosphere with all the charm of an old fashion county fair (animals, fair food, vendors etc.). The competition is a rain or shine event held out of doors under an open tent. Dancers will be dancing on a 30 ft by 30 ft custom built wooden dance floor.

Directions:

The Orange County Fair will be held at Montpelier Station, VA behind [Montpelier's](#) old Visitor's Center on Virginia Route 20, approximately 4 miles west of the [Town of Orange, Virginia](#).

From Washington DC:

From 66 W, take RT 29 S. to Culpeper; exit onto RT 15 S. toward Orange. At Orange, take a right at the second stoplight onto RT 20 S. Go about 4 miles. Fair will be on your right.

OR take I-95 S to Fredericksburg; exit onto RT 3 W toward Culpeper. Make a left onto RT 20 S; continue to the town of Orange. Go about 4 miles past town. Fair will be on your right.

From Richmond, VA:

Take I-64 W to Zions Crossroads. Exit onto RT 15 N to Orange. At Orange, merge onto RT 20 S; go about 4 miles. Fair will be on your right.

From Charlottesville, VA:

Take RT 29 N. to Ruckersville; take a right onto RT 33 E. At Barboursville, take a left onto RT 20 N toward Orange; go about 8 miles. Fair will be on your left.

Entries and Registration:

Entries will be accepted in the order received. Order of dance for all team and duo/duet dances will be in reverse order (first registered will dance last). Registration must be postmarked by June 12, 2010. There will be no team registration at the door. Only solos will be allowed to register at the door. If a problem arises and you cannot get your registration postmarked in time, please contact us immediately via phone or email.

Competition Fees:

\$8.00 – Per dancer/Per Dance/Category.

Spectator Fees:

All Paid Dancers and Director admitted FREE. Entry tickets will be mailed to teams prior to competition.

All other spectators pay upon entry into the fair. This is not just a spectator fee but an entry fee to enjoy the fair as well as the competition.

Awards:

Trophies will be awarded to all first, second, and third place teams, solos, and duo/duets. Grand Champion trophies will be awarded to the highest scoring team in each category.

The Spirit Award will be awarded to the team with the most spirit and enthusiasm for all the competing dancers.

Dressing Areas:

Dancers will be provided with dressing areas.

Music & Sound:

All music must be on CD. It is recommended that you have one song on each CD for your protection. Back up music should be available in case of emergency. Speed checks will be provided off stage via headphones prior to the dance. There will be NO on-stage sound or speed checks.

ACHF World Championship Qualifications:

This is an America's Clogging Hall of Fame sanctioned competition. All entrants are subject to ACHF rules.
